Camping adult who is responsible for campsite must be 19 years of age.

Anyone leaving the campgrounds must have a Camping parking permit in rear view mirror. Or you will have to pay to get in. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Camping unit shall consist of: One tent, One trailer, or One truck camper, Etc. If an additional small tent is needed a \$5.00 fee will be added regardless of how long the tent is occupying the space. Any additional tent must remain within your campsite.

All camping units shall have an ADULT IN ATTENDANCE AT ALL TIMES!

All Electric connections need to be grounded.

NO REFRIGERATORS OR FREEZERS ARE ALLOWED OUTSIDE OF CAMPER, unless pre-approved by the Sr. Fair Board Camping Chair person.

Camping site number and name or camping registration tag must be displayed on all units so it is visible from the road.

Golf carts are to be driven by a licensed driver 18 years or older ONLY. And follow speed limit signs 5 miles per hour.

1st warning written citation. 2nd warning, no longer allowed to have golf cart on grounds.

Must have golf cart registration on cart always. (if applicable)

Pets are to be confined to the campground, remain leashed and under control.

Pets are not permitted on the midway or near food stands. You are responsible to clean up after your pet. Please be considerate of other campers.

FIREWORKS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.

Due to health code regulations, all waste water Black/Gray water must be in appropriate containers.

Do not allow waste water to drain on the ground.

Weather permitting, you will be allowed to have a camp fire. An adult (over 19) must be present at all times. You must clean up after fire. Please clean up ashes and any wood left over. You will be charged a \$25 fee if you do not clean up after your fire. NO BURNING OF PALLETS! CLEAN FIREWOOD ONLY!

All garbage must be in dumpster by Building B2 and B3. If any garbage left at your site, you will be charged a \$25 fee.
